DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue one right-of-entry permit to the Elem Indian Colony and one right-of-entry permit to Lake County Sanitation District for Anderson Marsh State Historic Park in Lake County to restore fisheries and replace an antiquated clay sewer line for the Seigler Creek Fisheries Restoration Project.

The Notice of Exemption for this Project was filed by the County of Lake on March 5, 2015 Ref#17-2015-013. All required regulatory permits will be obtained by the Elem Indian Colony and Lake County prior to any work beginning on the Project.

All work conducted pursuant to these ROEs, and related project work, will comply with all state and federal environmental laws, including but not limited to CEQA, NEPA, the Endangered Species Act, Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code, and conditions specified by the ROEs and other permitting agencies.


