PROJECT TITLE: Frog Lake Trail and Spillway Repairs

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Repair trail and spillway at Frog Lake in Henry W. Coe State Park to address erosion problems.

Work will:

- Excavate up to 1' of soil and construct 15' long X 5' wide rock armored trail surface using 100+ pound granite rocks, and
- Construct 15' long X 5' wide and 8' high multi-tier rock retaining wall along spillway and edge of the trail.
