PROJECT TITLE: Conference Center Door Locks Upgrade

LOCATION: Asilomar State Beach and Conference Grounds

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace door locks at the conference center at Asilomar State Beach and Conference Grounds to modernize and upgrade the locking system to provide increased safety and security for park visitors and staff.

Work will:

- Remove existing door locks and handles from all guest, restroom and meeting rooms and replace with new keyless locks and handles that utilize secure access cards, and
- Mount six (6) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" x 5/8" hot spot technology wall readers to non-historic buildings to enable guests to update access cards as needed.
- Extend internal wiring, as needed, to connect new wall reader units to existing electrical systems.
