DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace deteriorated wood shingle roofs and complete any repair/maintenance work required on the interiors of two service area buildings in Columbia State Historic Park to protect and maintain the structures. On each building work will:

- Remove existing evaporative coolers, roofing materials and gutters;
- Repair/replace roof framing as needed,
- Install new metal roofs, gutters, downspouts and splash blocks.
- Reinstall removed evaporative coolers;
- Repair or replace any deteriorated exterior siding, trim, doors, and/or eaves;
- Repaint exterior in the same Oxford brown as existing;
- Repair or replace interior acoustic ceiling panels;
- Replace missing light fixtures and diffusers;
- Install interior baseboards and paint building's interiors;
- Prepare and paint cement floor in maintenance office.


