**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

Install a new county bus stop sign in the overflow parking area of Railtown 1897 State Historic Park to provide better public transportation access for park visitors. The project area is in previously disturbed soil. Work will excavate approximately 24" deep by 6" in diameter for post hole; install post with sign attached and backfill hole with cement to secure post.


