Issue an easement to the Creek and Glenn Drives Property Owners Association for the reconstruction, replacement, repair, operation and maintenance of a vehicular and pedestrian bridge across Apfos Creek and to Pacific Gas & Electric Company for the location, repair and maintenance of the gas pipe attached to said bridge located at Seacliff State Beach.

All work conducted within the boundaries of the easement, including routine maintenance will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, CEQA, and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code, with regard to work conducted within the easement.

The State reserves the right to use said real property in any manner, provided such use does not unreasonably interfere with the Creek and Glenn Drives Property Owners Association.


