PROJECT TITLE: Alberding Building Kitchen Renovation

LOCATION: Columbia State Historic Park

COUNTY: Tuolumne

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Renovate the kitchen area of the Alberding Building in Columbia State Historic Park to create a more usable kitchen space for the new Concessionaire. Work will:

- Demolish existing interior partition wall including electrical and plumbing within this wall;
- Construct a new interior partition wall in a different location to create a larger kitchen; this wall will contain new electrical, plumbing and propane gas lines for kitchen appliances; wall will be finished using gypsum board, bead board paneling, paint, base boards and trim;
- Install a new electrical circuit to serve kitchen appliances;
- Install new waste drain;
- Install new 24" commercial exhaust/ventilation flue with ANSUL fire suppression system through the ceiling within the new kitchen area;
- Patch roof as necessary and install roof curb and weather proof cover;
- Replace sheet vinyl flooring in new kitchen area and in existing office.
