PROJECT TITLE: Meadow Hill Water Tank Road Repairs

LOCATION: Millerton Lake State Recreation Area

COUNTY: Madera

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Repair the shoulder drainage on the road to the Meadow Hill water plant on the north shore of Millerton Lake State Recreation Area to control continued water erosion. Work will:

- Install three (3) metal drainage flumes alongside the road to channel water runoff into natural drainages;
- Approximately 400 feet from the lower gate at road curve, add 5 feet of 3" asphalt to each side of the road to facilitate vehicle traffic;
- At same location, remove the crown of the road to facilitate drainage; and
- Repair three (3) pot holes with asphalt.

The project will involve no more than 3" to 5" of excavation removing approximately 1 yard of material.
