**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Issue Right of Way Permit renewal to KSBW-TV for access to adjacent private property in Fremont Peak State Park. Permit allows for the ingress and egress by Permittee of San Juan Grade Road and Peak Road in the park. Permit term is for no longer than ten years.

All work conducted in association with the Right of Entry will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code.
