PROJECT TITLE: Roadway Signage and Striping Improvements

LOCATION: Mount Diablo State Park

COUNTY: Contra Costa

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install new safety and regulator signs, roadway striping, and test passing areas on Northgate, Southgate, and Summit Roads at Mount Diablo State Park to enhance public safety. Work will:

- Remove 26 existing road safety and regulatory signs and install up to 93 new signs. New signs will be attached to 4" x 4" wood posts set in holes up to 8" diameter by two feet deep.
- Restripe roadway with double yellow striping and passing striping, with reflective pavement markers installed on the road center.
- Establish three test bike turnouts by painting existing pavement and repairing any compromised existing pavement, slurry seal an existing gravel and paved turnout, and pave an existing gravel shoulder with approximately 3,480 sq. ft. of AC pavement.
