DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue Right of Entry (ROE) to Humboldt County into Humboldt Redwoods State Park for the installation of a temporary bridge crossing on the Eel River to provide improved emergency access and agricultural commerce to the community of Shively during the summer months. Installation of a bridge has occurred annually at the same location since the early 1900's.

All work conducted pursuant to this ROE and related project work will comply with all state and federal environmental laws, including but not limited to CEQA, NEPA, the Endangered Species Act, Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code, and conditions specified by this ROE and other permitting agencies.


