DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Repaint the Riverside Bridge at Castle Crags State Park to protect it from rust and corrosion. Work will:

- Close the bridge to public use for up to 1 week;
- Surround the sections to be painted with plastic containment to prevent material from entering the Sacramento River; and
- Scrap off old paint and apply new paint with rollers and brushes.
