PROJECT TITLE: North Beach Parking Lot Repairs and Seal Coat

LOCATION: Marshall Gold Discovery State Historic Park COUNTY: El Dorado

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Repair, improve and apply seal coat to the North Beach parking lot within Marshall Gold Discovery SHP, to fix uplifted areas and accommodate additional buses. Work will:

- Saw cut and remove the approximately 100' x 50' landscaped island and remove 3" of material to add road base and patch with asphalt;
- Saw cut and remove five areas (5'x9', 16'x7', 4'x5', 16'x4' and 9'x19') where tree roots are uplifting the asphalt, remove problem roots, add 4-6" of road base and patch with asphalt; and
- Apply seal coat to entire parking lot and restripe to designate 11 new bus parking stalls 40' long x 15' wide.

Projects consists of repairs and reconstruction of an existing public facility with no expansion of use beyond current levels; the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new facility will be located on the same site as the facility replaced, and; minor public alterations in the condition of vegetation that does not involve removal of healthy, mature or scenic trees included as "road sealing/repairs of existing surfaces" and "removal of individual members of non-threatened or endangered species" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR §15300.4.
