PROJECT TITLE: Weather Station Install, Cuneo Horse Camp

LOCATION: Humboldt Redwoods State Park COUNTY: Humboldt

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install a new weather station, and tower at the Cuneo Creek Horse Campground in Humboldt Redwoods State Park to replace the existing outdated weather station with a modern version that will provide park staff and the public with access to real-time meteorological data via the internet. Work will:

- Adjacent to the existing weather station, excavate by hand or gas powered auger a 2' deep by 2' wide by 2' long area, pour concrete, and mount a 10-foot tall weather station tower;
- Adjacent to the new tower location, excavate by hand a 3' long by 1' wide by 2' deep trench and install a soil moisture sensor;
- Download data, dismantle, and remove the existing outdated weather station;
- Around the new tower location, excavate by hand or gas powered auger four (4) 1' diameter by 2' deep holes, fill with cement and secure corner posts, and install 6-foot tall chain link security fencing with plastic slats for screening. Each side will be approximately eight (8) feet in length; and
- Manage vegetation within a 100-foot radius of the new weather station tower to maintain the obstruction-free horizon from the top of the tower.



REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of replacement of existing structures where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced; minor public alterations in the condition of land and/or vegetation that do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees; and basic data collection and resource evaluation activities that do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource.
