PROJECT TITLE: Ledson Marsh Spillway Replacement and Valve Installation
LOCATION: Annadel State Park **COUNTY:** Sonoma

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace the undermined concrete spillway and install a valve to control water levels on the Ledson Marsh dam in Annadel State Park to protect dam from possible failure and for the long-term preservation of the marsh. Work will:

- Dewater area around the spillway;
- Install safety fencing around all construction locations and install frog exclusionary fencing around main construction area and along sides of the dam along the construction access route;
- Remove existing spillway (approximately 20 CY of material);
- Over-excavate and remove approximately 250 CY of soil;
- Install 24 CY of clay lining and cutoff trench forming impervious barrier;
- Install flow/level control structure consisting of 150' of HDPE pipe, inlet, 4' x 4' concrete box with lockable lid, a 6' x 1.8' x 1.5' level control structure, and 1.8 CY of 6" D50 rock for an outlet energy dissipator; and
- Reconstruct spill way with 11 CY of reinforced concrete and install 15 CY of 18" D50 rock to improve the rock energy dissipator.

All work will be done to maintain the historic values of the dam, and will meet Secretary of Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.




REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of minor alterations of land which do not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees; and maintenance, repair, and rehabilitation of historic resources in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995), Weeks and Grimmer.
