PROJECT TITLE: Install Iron Ranger & Parking Bollards

LOCATION: South Yuba River State Park

COUNTY: Nevada

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install an iron ranger and parking bollards at the Covered Bridge Parking Lot in South Yuba River State Park to collect parking fees for day use revenue generation. Work will:

- Eliminate one (1) non-accessible asphalt parking space; paint over existing parking space lines with black paint; use for access to iron ranger.
- Excavate one (1) approximately 2' long x 4 wide' x 2' deep hole for installation of a footing for the iron ranger and excavate four (4) 1' x 1' x 2' deep holes to install four (4) parking bollards; fill holes with concrete and place iron ranger and bollards in the concrete to secure.
- Follow Best Management Practices; place straw wattles around the work area; store equipment on pavement at work area. Wash hand tools and excavator prior to and after leaving project site; remove and haul debris to a local disposal agency to be recycled.
