DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Project proposes to replace the existing cedar shake roof on the Scapucino House at Indian Grinding Rock State Historic Park to protect the building from water damage and allow for its continued use. Work will:

- Remove and dispose of the existing wood shakes;
- Install half-inch plywood sheeting;
- Install ice and water shield underlayment;
- Install 26 gauge (minimum) galvanized corrugated sheet metal roofing and flashing and;
- Install approximately 120 feet of gutter and downspouts.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the repair, maintenance and minor alteration of existing public or private structures involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced and is included as "Reroofing" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR § 15300.4; and consists of projects limited to maintenance, repair, stabilization, rehabilitation, restoration, preservation, conservation, or reconstruction of historical resources, in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties, with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995), Weeks and Grimmer.
