**PROJECT TITLE:** Angel Island Perimeter Road Park Bench Replacement

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

On Angel Island, replace six dilapidated wooden park benches with new plastic/steel park benches. The benches will be placed in the same perimeter road locations occupied by the old benches. Two concrete-filled, 8 inch diameter, 2 foot deep holes will be required for each installation.

The project manager shall coordinate with the department’s Accessibility Section to ensure the project conforms to the January 2005 California State Parks Accessibility Guidelines, Section 20, Fixed Benches. The project manager shall arrange with the Accessibility Section to document, photograph, verify and inspect the ongoing work in progress, and copies of all project documents shall be provided to the Accessibility Section.
