PROJECT TITLE: Forest Lodge Pole Lamps Relocation
LOCATION: Asilomar State Beach and Conference Grounds, Sunset Drive and Asilomar Avenue
COUNTY: Monterey

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Remove two existing light poles and concrete footings near the Forest Lodge building at Asilomar State Beach and Conference Grounds to relocate the lights closer to pathways. All trenching to extend new electrical lines to the lights will be hand dug to 6 inches wide and 24 inches deep. The first trench will extend from the existing light location to the new location approximately 16 feet away. The second trench will extend from a junction box that provides lighting to the Forest Lodge sign, to the edge of the walkway, along the walkway, and to the location of the proposed new light, approximately 12 feet away. Project supports continued use and maintenance and increases visitor safety.
