PROJECT TITLE: Mill Creek Bridge Replacement

PROJECT LOCATION: Burleigh Murray Ranch

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

At Burleigh Murray Ranch, replace an existing 40 foot long wooden vehicle/pedestrian bridge spanning Mill Creek. Portions of the existing bridge are rotted and only one concrete abutment was originally installed. Following removal of the existing bridge, a second concrete abutment will be constructed by excavating a 2 ft. x 3 ft. x 10 ft. trench sited 12 feet from the edge of Mill Creek. A pre-constructed railroad flat-car will be placed on the existing and newly poured concrete abutments. All work will be conducted in a manner as to prevent spoils or any other materials from entering the creek. The new bridge will be approximately 45 feet in length.
