PROJECT TITLE: Beals Point Accessibility Improvements

LOCATION: Beals Point, Auburn-Folsom Road and Oak Hill Drive, Folsom State Recreation Area

COUNTY: Placer

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Make improvements at two RV campsites and the parking area for the amphitheater to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. Work includes:

RV Campground: At campsite 65, extend both sides of existing parking with compacted fill material.

At campsites 65 and 67: Adjust fire ring height to 20"-24", with inside filled to a minimum of 9" above exterior surface. This will require newly compacted area to be excavated approximately 6" deep X 30" round. Anchor table with "duck bill" anchors by driving two metal anchors, approximately 6" long X 2" round, into the ground approximately 12"-18" with a cable that will attached to the table. Surround existing hose bibb and electrical hookup area with concrete approximately 6' wide X 15' long X 4" deep to provide a minimum clearance of 3' around any obstacles. Raise hose bib to a height of 28"-36" (top of spigot).

Amphitheater Parking: Remove approximately 15' X 40' of asphalt in existing parking spaces, regrade to less than 2% slope, and repave with concrete or asphalt with road base. Restripe parking and provide a transition from parking to existing walkway.
