PROJECT TITLE: Install Two Residential Trailer Pads and Vehicle Access **COUNTY:** Santa Cruz

PROJECT LOCATION: New Brighton State Beach

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Install two trailer pads and associated vehicle driveways and parking areas for employee trailer housing. Each trailer pad measures 25 feet by 60 feet and each parking area measures 30 feet by 40 feet. Trailer pads, driveways and parking areas will consist of 6 inch deep road base. Install a new underground sewage station between the trailer pads. New underground utility lines for sewer, potable water, electric and phone services will be installed and connected to existing park utilities. Utilities will be installed in three trenches measuring 24 inches deep by 12 inches wide together which total 450 linear feet. Construct a wooden privacy fence adjacent to one of the trailer pads. Construction equipment and materials staging and storage areas will be restricted to existing graded gravel and paved surfaces. In the event that previously undocumented cultural resources are encountered during project construction, work will cease at the location of the find until a DPR archaeologist has evaluated the find and implemented appropriate treatment and disposition of the artifact(s).

Project consists of minor new construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities and structures and consists of minor alterations in the conditions of land and vegetation which does not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees; included as "installation of parking lots, mobile home pads, with utility connections" and minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored" on the Department of Park and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR 15300.4 of park related facilities and is consistent with "mobile home pads with utility connections" on the Department of Park and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR 15303.
