PROJECT TITLE: Enclose Open Wagon Shed

LOCATION: William B. Ide Adobe State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Tehama

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Enclose existing period wagon shed and smithy area constructed in 1961 with 4 stalls which together measure approximately 18 feet wide by 36 feet length. Two of the stalls will have fixed closures and two will have sliding barn-style doors. Doors and closures will each measure approximately 10 feet wide for overlap and securing the shed. Excavate along the front of the shed up to approximately 44 feet in length in order to install material for support of stall closures and doors. Move hose bibb and/or water line locations adjacent to the shed to make space for the stall and door/closure installations.

Excavation will not be done below 12 inches in depth. Clean fill will be used to level soil surfaces. In the event that previously undocumented cultural resources are encountered during project construction, work will cease at the location of the find until the find has been evaluated and an appropriate data treatment program is designed and implemented. Such cultural resource management activities will be conducted by or under the supervision of a California Department of Parks and Recreation qualified-archaeologist.

Project consists of minor alteration of existing public structure involving negligible expansion of use beyond current levels and consists of the minor alteration in the condition of land that does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry purposes; and is listed in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR §15300.4.
