PROJECT TITLE: Post Replacement and Gate Repair

LOCATION: Weaverville-Joss House State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Trinity

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Replace rotted gate posts, various fence posts and repair two redwood gates on the South and West side of the Temple lawn at Weaverville-Joss House State Historic Park to maintain the facility. Work will remove gates, repair with restoration product Abatron® and paint to match existing fence; cut mortise holes in posts to receive the tenons, install two new posts for each gate and reinstall. Posts will be removed and the holes dug out to a depth of 2 feet using concrete for installation of the new posts.
