**PROJECT TITLE:** California Coastal Trail Sign Installation

**LOCATION:** Monterey State Beach, Highway One

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

Install four new 3” by 3” signs along the California Coastal Trail where it passes through the Seaside Beach area at Monterey State Beach for health and safety. Project work will excavate four post holes in sandy, pre-disturbed areas approximately 3’ deep and 2’ wide; fill the holes with concrete; install 2’ of 4” x 4” posts in the concrete ensuring that 3’ of the posts extend above ground level to comply with “California State Parks Accessibility Guidelines”; and attach signs to posts. This project will not impact any sensitive resources.
