PROJECT TITLE: Bloomer Boat-In Campground Vault Toilets

LOCATION: Lake Oroville State Recreation Area **COUNTY:** Butte County

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Install two vault toilets at each of the three boat-in camp sites, collectively known as Bloomer Boat-In Campgrounds at Lake Oroville State Recreation Area to replace existing vault toilets that are not American with Disabilities (ADA) compliant. Work will remove existing buildings; fill the vaults with excavated dirt; excavate holes 12' x 16' x 6' deep for the new toilets; grade a 4 percent slope for 12' away from the new toilets using excess dirt; and install new ADA compliant vault toilets. Additional work will trim or remove some shrubs. A DPR archeologist and a Native American will monitor all ground disturbing activities for cultural resources at one of the campground sites.
