DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue Right of Entry Permit (ROE), issue easement, and transfer ownership of land to designated entities to construct the Los Angeles Museum of the Holocaust at Pan Pacific Park.

- Issue temporary ROE to the Los Angeles Museum of the Holocaust to utilize State-owned property for construction staging and access.
- Issue easement in perpetuity to the City of Los Angeles (City) to access and maintain existing utilities located on approximately 0.10 acre of State-owned property.
- Transfer ownership of approximately 0.08 acre of State-owned property and associated facilities and appurtenances to the City to maintain utilities for the museum.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of minor alteration in land use limitations in areas with an average slope of less than 20%, which do not result in any changes in land use or density; transfer of ownership in interests in land in order to preserve open space, habitat, or historical resources; and is included as "issuance of easements and permit," and "issuance of rights-of-way" in the Department of Parks and Recreation list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR § 15300.4.
