PROJECT TITLE: Structure Removal - Wilde Parcels (15420 Highway-299W and 10726 French Alley)

LOCATION: Shasta State Historic Park

COUNTY: Shasta

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Demolish an abandoned, non-historic structure and one unattached garage on the newly acquired "Wilde Parcels" at Shasta State Historic Park to improve the visual landscape of the park and reduce vandalism. The basement of the residence will have its perimeter stem walls broken to six to twelve inches below grade, dumped inward, with the remainder of the basement interior filled in with the same material used for filling septic tanks. Additional work will abandon two septic tanks; the tops of the septic tanks will be opened and filled with material from the demolished buildings and stockpiled dirt. Material deemed unsuitable for recycling or reuse, will be used to fill the basement of the residence and the septic tanks or hauled and disposed of at approved solid waste and/or hazardous waste facilities. All known or presumed hazardous material disposal will follow State and federal regulations.
