PROJECT TITLE: Water Tank Area Eucalyptus Removal
LOCATION: Julia Pfeiffer Burns State Park
COUNTY: Monterey

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Remove an approximately ¼ acre grove of invasive *Eucalyptus globulus* located uphill from employee residence and water tanks at Julia Pfeiffer Burns State Park to restore the coastal scrub vegetation community.. Work will remove approximately 112 trees ranging in size from ½ inch to 13" diameter at breast height using chainsaws. The small branches will be chipped and dispersed evenly on-site and the trees will be cut into logs for firewood. Additional work will treat all stumps with a 50% Garlon 4 Ultra herbicide mixture to prevent re-sprouting.
