PROJECT TITLE: Camp 1 Dining Hall Reroofing, Chimney and Woodwork Repairs

LOCATION: Mendocino Woodlands State Park

COUNTY: Mendocino

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Replace existing roofing, chimney, and woodwork on the Camp 1 Dining Hall at Mendocino Woodlands State Park to preserve the historic structure. The project will involve limited in-kind replacement and, epoxy repair of deteriorated roof system woodwork; replacement of the roof deck with asphalt shingles; repair and replacement of chimney flashings with sheet lead; and cleaning and limited repainting of chimney stonework. Additional exterior woodwork treatments will include limited in-kind replacement of deteriorated redwood board-and-batten wall siding and damaged window and foundation vent sills; reconstruction and repair of deteriorated doors, and reconstruction of the Main Entry stairs, log Pergola, and south Dining Wing stair entry. Replace a non-historic stair unit on the building with an approximately 29 foot (ft) long by 6 ft wide by 2 ft tall ADA accessible ramp.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

Project consists of the repair and minor alteration of existing public structures and facilities involving no expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity; repair and maintenance of historical resources, in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995), Weeks and Grimmer; included as "modifications of existing facilities for handicap access" and "reroofing" in the Department of Parks and Recreation list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR §15300.4.
