DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Relocate Founders Grove approximately 200 feet west of its original location on Angel Island State Park to provide a scenic view of Ayala Cove. Work will hand excavate a 10" by 12" long trench to move a waterline and faucet approximately 15 feet to the western edge of the site, level an approximately 400 square foot area by hand and cover with decomposed granite, add approximately 50 various types of plants around the site and replace a picnic table with two benches. Additional work will excavate a 12" by 18" inch deep posthole to install an interpretive panel down slope of the site.
