PROJECT TITLE: Administrative Area Improvements

LOCATION: China Camp State Park

COUNTY: Marin

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Make improvements to the administrative area at the China Camp State Park to upgrade facilities. Work will remove an abandoned mobile office trailer, a 38-foot by 12-foot high above ground concrete water treatment tank, (including tank foundation), and 300 feet of chain link fence. A recreational vehicle residence pad and a modular home pad will be installed in the vicinity of the old office and will require minor trench excavations to relocate existing utility lines. Additional work will include constructing up to 2,000 feet new trail to realign the Shoreline Trail out of the residential area.

Project consists of the maintenance and minor alteration of existing public structures including the demolition and removal of individual small structures involving negligible expansion of use beyond current levels, the construction and locating limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures, and the minor alterations of land and/or vegetation which do not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees included as “construction or installation of park facilities, such as mobile home pads,” and “trail construction or realignment” on the Department of Parks and Recreation’s list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR §15300.4.
