PROJECT TITLE: Gas Station Restoration

LOCATION: South Yuba River State Park

COUNTY: Nevada

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Restore the historic gas station to its original condition and appearance at South Yuba River State Park. Work will:

- Restore and replace missing windows, doors, trim and siding to replicate the original exterior of the building.
- Repair/replace roof and mudsill.
- Repair overhanging and enclose soffits.
- Remove interior paneling to inspect studs, mudsill and concrete foundation.
- Remove existing non-historic cabinets.
- Inspect electrical, plumbing and repair crack in floor.
- Install garage doors on south wall.
- Pressure wash exterior for painting to original colors.
- Construct a portico to include columns, headers, ceiling joists, rafters with enclosed soffit, skip sheeting and cedar shingles.
- Install two 2' x 2' concrete footing in the front of the structure and install portico support posts.
- Trench 32 feet in length x 12" wide x 2' in depth to install a French drain along the outside rear wall to reduce moisture intrusion to the structure.
