PROJECT TITLE: South Shore Maintenance Yard Improvements

LOCATION: Millerton Lake State Recreation Area

COUNTY: Fresno

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Improve the South Shore Maintenance Yard at Millerton Lake State recreation Area to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and meet current Health and Safety Guidelines. Work will demolish seven existing, deteriorated service yard buildings and construct new ADA compliant buildings, a boat storage shell, and a multi-purpose water station with an evaporation pond. Specific work will:

- Reconstruct an approximately 60'Lx60'W and 15' tall service building with an approximately 60'Lx5'Wx4"D concrete pedestrian walkway; excavate up to 2' for foundation, remove existing asphalt and replace with new to modify parking to comply with ADA. Utilities work will excavate an approximately 2'Wx2'D and 110 feet long trench to install 2" conduit for electric supply and approximately 2'Wx6'D to install a 4" conduit for a sewer line.
- Reconstruct an approximately 53'Lx30'W and 15' high storage building with an approximately 53'Lx5'Wx4"D concrete pedestrian walkway, excavate up to 2' for foundation. Utility work will excavate approximately 2'Wx2'D and 110 feet long trench to install 2" conduit for electric supply and approximately 2'Wx2'D and 200 feet long to install 2" conduit for a water line; relocate existing truck filler.
- Reconstruct approximately 50'Lx 100'w and 15' high boat storage shell with an approximately 100'Lx5'Wx 3" deep asphalt concrete pedestrian walkway, excavate up to 2' for foundation.
- Install an approximately 30"Lx20'Wx 6"D concrete slab multi-purpose water station with an approximately 50'Lx30'Wx18" evaporation pond, excavate approximately 12" to install an approximately 12' diameter above ground gray-water storage tank on a gravel pad. Utilities work will excavate approximately 2'Wx2'D and 25 feet long trench for 2" conduit for electric supply and an approximately 2'Wx4'D and 205' feet long trench for 2" conduit for gray-water transfer line.

Additional work will upgrade the electrical panel to current requirements; all utilities will connect to existing lines, and install two 10,000 gallon water storage tanks for fire suppression.



REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing public facilities involving negligible expansion of use beyond current levels; replacement of existing structures where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced; and minor public alteration in the condition of land that does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
