**PROJECT TITLE:** Issue a Right-of-Entry Permit to The City of Santa Rosa and its subcontractors

**LOCATION:** Annadel State Park

**COUNTY:** Sonoma

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Issue right-of-entry permit to the City of Santa Rosa and its subcontractors to allow access along 5300 linear feet of Channel Drive at Annadel State Park to relocate their trunk sewer line. The City of Santa Rosa and its subcontractors will repair road related damage on Channel Drive upon completion of the project by removing severely cracked or rutted roadway areas and replacing with 3 inch thick layer of asphalt concrete (hereinafter referred to as dig-outs). Lightly cracked areas will be cracked sealed. Upon completion of the dig-outs and crack sealing on Channel Drive, from west of the controlled entry gate to the park boundary, a distance of approximately 2400 feet, the roadway will be fog sealed to upon completion of the project. Upon completion of the dig-outs and crack sealing on Channel Drive, from east of the controlled park entry gate to the westerly boundary of the Oakmont Treatment Plant Storage pond, a distance of approximately 2900 feet, the roadway will be slurried sealed upon completion of the project. The City of Santa Rosa and or its subcontractors will have traffic control staff on site as necessary. All work conducted in association with the Right of Entry will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and section 5024 of the Public Resources Code, DPR will advise The City of Santa Rose and its Contractors if any new historical resources (including archaeological sites), special status species, Threatened/Endangered Species, or other resource issues are identified within the area.
