PROJECT TITLE: Issue a Right of Entry and Easement to Placer County

LOCATION: Kings Beach State Recreation Area **COUNTY:** Placer

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue a Right of Entry (ROE) to Placer County to install infrastructure at the park entrance and parking lot at Kings Beach State Recreation area and a permanent easement to allow Placer County and their contractors to maintain work completed at Kings Beach State Recreation Area. Placer County will notify the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) at least one week prior to performing work, including routine maintenance, within the easement boundaries. Advance notice is not required when responding to an emergency, however, DPR will be notified as soon as feasible after Placer County personnel arrive at the site. All work constructed within the boundaries of the easement, including routine maintenance and will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, CEQA, and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code, with regard to work conducted within the easement. If potentially significant resources are unearthed, work in the immediate area of the find will be temporarily halted or diverted until the project manager consults with a DPR archaeologist, and identification and proper treatment are determined and implemented. All finds become the property of DPR; ownership of any Native American artifacts will be determined on a case-by case basis, in consultation with the appropriate tribal representative(s) and/or the Native American Heritage Commission. DPR or approved qualified biologist to conduct Tahoe Yellow Cress (TYC) surveys in future years during the appropriate time prior to construction with the condition that Placer County must avoid impact if any TYC is found. This easement will provide legal access and use of this property to Placer County, while protecting natural resources.
