DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Issue a right of Entry (ROE) to South Tahoe Public Utility District for emergency repair to the existing 12" gravity sewer pipeline crossing the Upper Truckee River near the westerly end of Country club Drive at Lake Valley State Recreation Area.

All work conducted in association with the Right of Entry will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code. DPR will advise South Tahoe Public Utility District if any new historical resources (including archaeological sites), special status species, Threatened/Endangered species or other resource issues are identified within the area.
