DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The project involves the installation of a sewage dump station for the use by recreation vehicles. The installation will involve subsurface disturbance to a depth of 6.5 feet and surface area of 9000 sq feet. The proposed dump station will tie into existing lift station/sewer that supports the existing facilities. No external permits will be sought or required.
