PROJECT TITLE: Install Insulated Roofs on Museum Cottages

LOCATION: Antelope Valley Indian Museum SHP **COUNTY:** Los Angeles

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The project is to install insulated roofs and reroof three Cottages (Blue Bird, Lizard, and Butterfly Cottages) at the Antelope Valley Indian Museum SHP.

This project involves insulating and reroofing three cottages. The existing non-historic tar paper and asphalt shingles will be removed. Plywood will be installed to form a base for the roof and to provide structural stability. 1-inch-thick foam board insulation sheets will be placed over the plywood. The foam board will be covered with tar paper and asphalt shingles that match the green color of the historic roof. Metal flashing on the edge of the roof will cover and protect the historic roof boards and be painted to match the original.

The purpose of this project is to repair the Cottage's roof to prevent deterioration of historic fabric caused by roof leaks and to insulate the building to reduce utility costs. These Cottages are potentially eligible for the National Register of Historic Places; these repairs will be conducted in such a way as to not compromise the cottage's historic integrity. Repairs and treatment will be attempted before any historic fabric is replaced. Any replacement will be submitted for review prior to repair.
