**PROJECT TITLE:** SCSB Storm Drain Culvert Replacement (09-10-SD-36)

**LOCATION:** South Carlsbad State Beach      **COUNTY:** San Diego

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

This project consists of the replacement a failed section of a culvert in a storm drain system used by the City of Carlsbad and the campground at South Carlsbad State Beach. The storm drain runs in an easterly direction and begins 40' west of the #2 lane of southbound Carlsbad Blvd. (U.S. 101) the drain passes through SCSB campground (below campsites # 145 & 205) and empties at the beach. The majority of the storm drain will be installed within campsite #145, and the remainder will be installed just east of the campsite. Digging of a trench will be required to remove the failed section of the culvert and then to install the new section. The trench will be 8' wide, 3' deep, and 45' in length. The surrounding fence will be opened and repaired upon completion of project.
