DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

A storage shed will be installed in the maintenance yard at Saddleback Butte State Park in order to store tools, supplies, equipment, and to provide a work space for employees in natural resources. The proposed location is the south east corner of the maintenance yard, next to the chain link fence and other storage sheds. The shed is 12 ft x 16 ft with double doors which will face west. The shed has a window, skylight, and ventilation. A foundation is not required because the shed is designed to sit on any surface. The shed will be placed on gravel.
