DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The project would improve ADA accessibility within the building including addition of a restroom and kitchenette, interior modifications and additional utility infrastructure. Existing finishes affected by the work shall be restored. Measures to avoid and/or minimize impacts shall be implemented into the project.
