DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Disassemble and restore the fire damaged wooden double-entry gate on Juan Street of the Fiesta de Reyes in Old Town San Diego State Historic Park.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: No potential for significant impact to the environment is anticipated in compliance with CEQA §15300.2. If the project is implemented as indicated within the project description including conditions provided by specialists, then it is exempt under CEQA §15331– Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation. The action falls under the Departmental List of Exempt activities according to CEQA §15300.4 as “Activities affecting historic resources consistent with the Secretary of the Interior’s Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.”

Project consists of the maintenance, repair, and rehabilitation of an historic resource, in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995), Weeks and Grimmer (Class 31, Section 15331).
