**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

The intent of the project is to install permanent boundary markers along the perimeter of the Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve Extension property to facilitate determinations of land ownership questions, jurisdiction and to protect park resources.

**REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:** No potential for significant impact to the environment is anticipated in compliance with CEQA §15300.2. If the project is implemented as indicated within the project description including conditions provided by specialists, then it is exempt under CEQA §15303 - New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures. The action falls under the Departmental List of Exempt activities according to CEQA §15300.4 as "Construction or installation of park facilities such as kiosks, restrooms, small parking lots, interpretive signing or panels, fencing, signs, above-ground fuel and water tanks, mobile home pads with utility connections, camp host sites, fencing and gates, boat launching facilities, concessionaire structures, and tent cabins."
