**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

Install stainless steel lathe, poly membrane, and decomposed granite over the footing /adobe interface; to provide a positive slope and promote drainage away from and eliminate capillary moisture from intruding into and up the adobe wall of the Casa de Estudillo in Old Town San Diego State Historic Park to protect park resources.

The action falls under the Departmental List of Exempt activities according to CEQA §15300.4 as "Activities affecting historic resources consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties." Project consists of the maintenance, repair, and rehabilitation of an historic resource, in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995), Weeks and Grimmer (Class 31, Section 15331).
