PROJECT TITLE: Roof Replacement – San Clemente State Beach Auto Shop
LOCATION: San Clemente State Beach **COUNTY:** Orange

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The project proposes to replace the existing roof of the auto shop building. The building was built in 1950 and the extent of the re-roof will consist of (1) removal of existing three layers of asphalt tile roofing. (2) Repairs to sub-roof and fascia. (3) Installation of new felt underlayment. (4) Installation of new three tab asphalt shingles to replace like kind and match existing building roof patterns.

All repair work will be done in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and guidelines for the rehabilitation of historic properties. This is the replacement of an existing facility (roof) involving negligible expansion of capacity. It shall serve the same purpose as that being replaced. No ground disturbance or excavation will result from this project.
