**LOCATION:** San Clemente State Beach **COUNTY:** Orange

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

The Proposed Project seeks to make repairs to Historic Residence No. 7 (including its garage) at the Orange Coast District Headquarters Residence Area. The work will entail repairing the combined building and garage's 1,588 sq. ft. roofs. This will involve replacing missing or damaged fired clay roofing tiles. It will also involve repairing or replacing any damaged underlayment with new felt underlayment material as needed.

All repair work will be done in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and guidelines for the rehabilitation of historic properties. This is the replacement of an existing facility (roof) involving negligible expansion of capacity. It shall serve the same purpose as that being replaced. No ground disturbance or excavation will result from this project.
