DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Remove and replace non-historic wooden park perimeter and parking lot fencing along one block of Congress Street from Taylor Street south in Old Town San Diego SHP to protect park resources, public health and safety.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: No potential for significant impact to the environment is anticipated in compliance with CEQA §15300.2. If the project is implemented as indicated within the project description including conditions provided by CDPR specialists, then it is exempt under CEQA §15301 - Existing Facilities and §15303 - New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures. The action falls under the Departmental List of Exempt activities according to CEQA §15300.4 as:

- “Construction or installation of park facilities such as... fencing” (Class 3, Section 15303)
