**PROJECT TITLE:** Wooden Beach Stairway Repair (13/14-SD-10)

**LOCATION:** South Carlsbad State Beach - 652    **COUNTY:** San Diego

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

Repair to the main beach stairway at South Carlsbad State Beach will remove the damaged wood and replace with new pressure-treated wood. A middle supporting stringer will be added under the stair treads. The damaged sections of galvanized pipe railing will be cut out and new pipe welded in. All work is to be done with hand and power tools; no heavy equipment will be used. No work is to be done to the support legs or stairway/bluff interface. Workers may need to stand on the bluff at times to reach the work area.


