**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

The project involves the denial of access and exclusion of bats from the Fort Tejon Barracks by using humane exclusion techniques. The project will involve the placement of an exclusionary device (such as a one-way gate or flange) that will allow bats to leave but not return to roost inside the building. Following the exclusion, a ¼-inch screen will be placed inside the attic of the barracks to prevent the bats from getting inside the building.
